Goal:

To examine the care and protection of children.

Description:

This lesson presents various organizations and resources designed for the care and protection of children. Students will investigate and analyze various child centered resources including child care services, healthcare services and auxiliary services.

Objectives:

- 1. To examine the protection and safety of children.
- 2. To analyze community resources relevant to the care and protection of children.
- 3. To examine suggested preventative healthcare recommendations for children.

Lesson Plan

Class 1

Class Overview:

Essential Questions:

- 1. What types of child care resources are available for children?
- 2. What are the features of each type of child care service?

Step 1: Bell Ringer:

• Have students write down their answer to the first Essential Question.

Step 2: Distribute the Action Plan, Vocabulary Handout and Key Concepts.

• The Action Plan lays out a list of tasks for students to complete during the lesson.



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- The **Vocabulary Handout** is a list of terms used throughout the lesson.
- The **Key Concepts** is an outline which identifies the main ideas presented in the lesson which students can fill in to aid in note taking during the lesson.

Step 3: Show the *Child Care Services* PowerPoint[®] segment.

- This segment is 20 slides long.
- Be sure students utilize the Key Concepts for this segment of the lesson.

Step 4: Administer the Child Care Services Check for Understanding.

 The Check for Understanding is a short review of the content presented in the segment.

Step 5: Exit Ticket:

 Ask students to compare their answer to the Essential Question from the beginning of class to what they learned during class.

Essential Questions:

- 1. What are common medical conditions requiring healthcare for children?
- 2. Besides treating for medical conditions, what other types of healthcare is needed to keep children healthy?

Step 1: Bell Ringer:

• Think, Pair Share: Pose the **Essential Questions** to students and have them consider their response for one or two minutes before asking them to get into groups and share their responses.

Step 2: Show slides 21 to 38 of the *Healthcare Services* PowerPoint[®] segment.

- This portion of the segment is 18 slides long.
- Be sure students utilize the **Key Concepts** for this segment of the lesson.

Step 3: Students should complete the Pediatric Healthcare Professionals Activity.

• Students will investigate pediatric healthcare professionals and share findings with the class.

Step 4: Exit Ticket:

• Have students revisit their answers to the **Essential Questions** at the beginning of class and make any necessary changes and turn in.

Step 1: Bell Ringer:


• Post the question, "what is a community healthcare center," and have students look up the definition and share their findings with the class.

Step 3: Administer the Healthcare Services Check for Understanding.

• The Check for Understanding is a short review of the content presented in the segment.

Activity

Pediatric Healthcare Professionals

Students will investigate types of pediatric healthcare professionals and share their findings with the class.

Accommodations:

Provide a list of resources for students to use for their investigation.

Modifications:

Allow students to work with a partner. Provide a list of resources for students to use for their investigation. Reduce the number of pediatric professionals required to complete the activity.

Extension:

Have students locate a career interview with a pediatric professional and share the interview with the class.

Accommodations:

Provide a list of resources for students to use for their investigation. Allow extra time to complete the project.

Modifications:

Provide a list of resources for students to use for their investigation. Allow extra time to complete the project. Reduce the requirement from two organizations to one.

Extension:

Have students investigate additional community resources and have them explore career opportunities in one or more of the organizations.
